## FAMILY BOOK GLUB

1.	Locate copies of the same book for at least 2 people. One copy for you and one for another person in your family. If you need more than 2 copies—more than just you and one person wants to participate—let Ms. Henry know, and we'll see about locating more copies. ALSO—THINK ABOUT ELECTRONIC COPIES—KINDLE/AUDIBLE AND SUCH.
2.	As a family, decide on a timeline for reading/finishing the book. CHOOSE THE DATE THAT EVERYONE IN THE FAMILY WILL BE FINISHED WITH THE BOOK.
2	On the date that everyone is to be finished with the book, make a plan for the video taping session. Who will be there? Where will we be? Kitchen table? Den? Who will video? How will you be sure that everyone can be heard? What will guide your discussion? (LOOK ONLINE FOR BOOK CLUB QUESTIONS FOR THE BOOK—then use the questions to guide) How will you know for sure that everyone read the book?
3	Videotape your family discussion about the book. VIDEO SHOULD BE BETWEEN 5 AND 10 MINUTES. NO shorter than 5, NO longer than 10.
4	Upload the video to Youtube. Make sure you check the privacy settings you want.
5	Then, in another tab, log into GOOGLE CLASSROOM— click on IND READING PROJECT #2 in your stream. Then click ADD LINK. A BOX WILL POP UP—paste the link you copied from youtube into the space provided. Then click TURN IN. Your work is now turned in.
