- ILLUSTRATED CHARACTER ANALYSIS -

1	<p>Read your book.</p> <p>TIP: As you read, you may want to keep a sheet of paper in the book where you can jot down ideas you have for the new story—so you don't forget them.</p>
2	<p>Plan out your new story.</p> <p>Pull the main character from the novel you read.</p> <p>Place him/her in a new situation—but THEY ARE THE SAME PERSON, WITH THE SAME PERSONALITY TRAITS, VALUES, MORALS AND MEMORIES.</p> <p>Your new story will need OTHER CHARACTERS, A NEW SETTING, A NEW CONFLICT AND A NEW LESSON/THEME.</p> <p><i>I recommend writing ALL of this out of paper first—before you ever log in to Storybird.</i></p>
3	<p>Go to www.storybird.com</p> <p>REGISTER/CREATE A FREE ACCOUNT—using your school email address.</p> <p>I <u>DEFINITELY</u> recommend watching the HOW TO videos on the storybird website—they were very helpful to me in learning how to use the site.</p>
4	<p>Make your Storybird Story—when finished—save and PUBLISH!</p>
5	<p>After you publish—you will have the option to SHARE your work</p> <p>CLICK ON SHARE—then where it says SHARE LINK—highlight the link—then RIGHT CLICK THEN COPY.</p>
6	<p>Then, in another tab, log into GOOGLE CLASSROOM— click on IND READING PROJECT #2 in your stream.</p> <p>Then click ADD LINK. A BOX WILL POP UP—paste the link you copied from storybird into the space provided.</p> <p>Then click TURN IN. Your work is now turned in.</p>
