- ILLUSTRATED CHARACTER ANALYSIS -

1	Read your book. TIP: As you read, you may want to keep a sheet of paper in the book where you can jot down ideas you have for the new story—so you don't forget them.
2	Plan out your new story. Pull the main character from the novel you read. Place him/her in a new situation—but THEY ARE THE SAME PERSON, WITH THE SAME PERSONALITY TRAITS, VAL- UES, MORALS AND MEMORIES. Your new story will need OTHER CHARACTERS, A NEW SETTING, A NEW CONFLICT AND A NEW LESSON/THEME. <i>I recommend writing ALL of this out of paper first—before you ever log in to Storybird.</i>
3	Go to www.storybird.com REGISTER/CREATE A FREE ACCOUNT—using your school email address. I <u>DEFINITELY</u> recommend watching the HOW TO videos on the storybird website—they were very helpful to me in learning how to use the site.
4	Make your Storybird Story—when finished—save and PUBLISH!
5	After you publish—you will have the option to SHARE your work
6	Then, in another tab, log into GOOGLE CLASSROOM— click on IND READING PROJECT #2 in your stream. Then click ADD LINK. A BOX WILL POP UP—paste the link you copied from storybird into the space provided. Then click TURN IN. Your work is now turned in.
