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1	<b>Read your book.</b> TIP: As you read, you may want to keep a sheet of paper in the book where you can jot down ideas you have for the board game—so you don't forget them.
2	Go to www.thinglink.com and create an account—USING YOUR SCHOOL EMAIL.
	Your bullets should show deeper thinking about the novel—not just restating what happened in the novel.
3	How did the characters change?  What did the characters learn? (Theme)  What did you learn?  WHY is this a good book for pre-teens?  Personal critique?  Analyze the characters, the setting, the conflict.
4	Your thinglink should have NO LESS THAN 10 BUTTONS.
5	Save and publish your thinglink on the thinglink website in one tab. When you have your thinglink open, looking at it, highlight and copy the address in the address bar.
6	Then, in another tab, log into GOOGLE CLASSROOM— click on IND READING PROJECT #2 in your stream.  Then click ADD LINK. A BOX WILL POP UP—paste the link you copied from youtube into the space provided.  Then click TURN IN. Your work is now turned in.
